Grass Identification:

Go for a walk or explore the school grounds and look for long grass. Look carefully at the shape of the grass and the seeds. Use the grass



identification sheet attached showing the most common British grasses to name the type of grass you have found.

Grass craft:

Can you make a grass person? You will need:

- Long grass
- Scissors
- String



Fold your grass in half to make your head, body and legs. Tie string around the neck. Leave some grass sticking out for the arms and tie the remainder of grass at the waist. Split the ends of your grass to make legs. Tie the arms at the wrists and legs at the ankles. Trim the grass at the ends if required. Give your grass person a name, personality and even make them a mini den or hideout.
